The Perinatal ECHO is a virtual learning network intended for healthcare providers caring for pregnant patients and their newborns and aims to provide up-to-date guidance and sharing of best practices among those involved in perinatal health, as well as to increase access to information for those living in the rural areas of the state. Each 60-minute session may include a brief lecture, de-identified case presentation for participants to receive feedback on complex cases, and open discussion facilitated by an interdisciplinary team.

The Perinatal ECHO aims to provide up-to-date guidance and evidence-based practices to clinicians involved in perinatal health. Series topics are driven by current trends in Alaska and identified by an interdisciplinary team of healthcare providers.
